1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respective parties submit that during the pendency of the present appeal, the parties have already entered into a written compromise on 11.09.2025. Learned counsel for the parties submit that the said compromise has been effected in their presence by the parties concerned and the settlement deed has been signed by all in their presence and they have identified their respective parties to be genuine so as to enter into a written compromise.

2. Learned counsel for the respective parties pray that the present appeal may kindly be disposed of in terms of the compromise dated 11.09.2025 by invoking powers under Order 23 Rule 3 of the CPC.

3. The original settlement/compromise dated 11.09.2025 is taken on record and is marked as Annexure-A. On the joint request of the



respective parties, keeping in view the Order 23 Rule 3 of CPC, the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the said written compromise dated 11.09.2025, especially when learned counsel for the parties have submitted that the said compromise has been effected in their presence and they have identified the respective parties and they have also signed the compromise deed to prove the same.
