1. The present contempt petition is for non-compliance of conditions of compromise/settlement dated 05.08.2024 entered between the petitioner and respondent before Mediation and Conciliation of this Court.
2. On the last date of hearing i.e 26.08.2025, this Court passed the following order:-

“The present contempt petition is for non-compliance of conditions of compromise/settlement dated 05.08.2024 entered between the petitioner and respondent before Mediation and Conciliation of this Court.

As per compromise/settlement dated 05.08.2024 entered between the petitioner and respondent before Mediation and Conciliation of this Court, the respondent was to pay a total amount of Rs.45,00,000/- to the petitioner. In compliance of the same, the respondent has filed reply and along with reply, he has attached photocopy of demand draft of Rs.45,00,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner however contends that the demand draft is not handed over to the petitioner.



Learned counsel for the respondent seeks two days time to comply with conditions of compromise/settlement dated 05.08.2024 entered between the petitioner and respondent before Mediation and Conciliation of this Court and to bring demand draft of Rs.45,00,000/- to be handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner in the Court.

Adjourned to 28.08.2025.

Learned counsel for the respondent is directed to bring demand draft of Rs.45,00,000/- in the Court on the next date of hearing in compliance of compromise/settlement dated 05.08.2024, failing which the contempt proceedings shall be initiated against the respondent.

3. In compliance of the above order, learned counsel for the respondent has handed over a demand draft bearing No. 001246 dated 20.08.2025 for Rs.45,00,000/- in the name of the petitioner to learned counsel for the petitioner. The photocopy of the demand draft has been placed on record as Annexure A-1. Registry is directed to tag Annexure A-1 at an appropriate place.
4. In view of the above, the conditions of compromise/settlement dated 05.08.2024 entered between the petitioner and respondent before Mediation and Conciliation of this Court has been complied with.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.
6. Accordingly, the contempt is purged. Rule is discharged.
7. Pending application (s), if any also stands disposed of.
