The present application is for placing on record the affidavits of the petitioner as well as of the respondents No.2 and 3, as Annexure P-9 to P-11 respectively.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. Affidavits i.e. Annexures P-9 to P-11 are taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

Main Case

1. The petitioner in the present petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023, is seeking to quash the impugned FIR No. 59 dated 11.05.2020, registered under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on account of compromise dated 03.03.2023 (Annexure P-3), arrived at between the parties.

2. Mr. Avtar Singh Bhatti, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 and filed his power of attorney in Court today, which is taken on record. He confirms the factum of the compromise having been effected between the parties and states that respondents No.2 and 3 have no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

3. Learned State counsel states that no other FIR has been registered against the petitioner and he has not known criminal antecedents.

4. In that view of the matter, even if this case is taken to its logical conclusion, it would only be an exercise in futility as the parties have already settled their differences. Therefore, no purpose would be served in wasting the time and resources of the State in pursuing this case to its pre-ordained end. It would, therefore, be better to give a quietus to the issue at this stage.

5. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 59 dated 11.05.2020, registered under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala, and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom shall stand quashed.
