VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. By this common order, two appeals i.e., FAO Nos.2442 and 2445 of 1999 shall stand disposed of.

2. The present appeals arise from the decision on two claim petitions with respect to the accident which took place on 19.11.1995. FAO No.2442 of 1999 has been filed by the Insurance Company in the case of



Membati which is with respect to the injuries suffered by Membati for which compensation of an amount of Rs.28,500/- had been awarded to her. FAO No.2445 of 1999 has also been filed by the Insurance Company with respect to the award in favour of Mange Ram who had also suffered injuries in the same accident and had been awarded an amount of Rs.88,700/- along with interest.

3. On a pointed query raised by this Court, learned counsel for the appellant has very fairly submitted that since the interim order was vacated vide order dated 13.10.2000, thus, the amount in accordance with the award has already been paid to the respondents.

4. None has appeared on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the appellant, in view of the abovesaid subsequent event, has submitted that both the appeals be disposed of at this stage as having been rendered infructuous.

6. In view of the above, both the appeals are disposed of at this stage as having been rendered infructuous.

7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
