This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to the official respondents for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in their personal life.

Petitioner No.2 submits that she wants to go with her parents. In this regard statements of petitioner No.2 and her parents are recorded and is reproduced hereinbelow :-



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'STATEMENT OF NENA D/O MOHAR NATH AGED ABOUT 15 YEARS AND 6 MONTHS, R/O ANWALA, SULTANPUR, POST BARARI, DISTRICT MATHURA ON S.A.

I voluntarily want to go with my father Mr. Mohar Nath and my mother Suman who are present in Court.

The afore-said statement of mine is without any fear, coercion or undue influence.'

STATEMENT OF MOHAR NATH S/O DAL NATH R/O ANWALA, SULTANPUR, POST BARARI, DISTRICT MATHURA ON S.A.

It is stated that I am willing to take my daughter who is present in court and I will take care of my Daughter Nena aged about 15 years 6 months with affection and love.

The afore-said statement of mine is without any fear, coercion or undue influence.'

In view of the above, petitioner No.2 is directed to be released from Aashiana, Sector-15, Chandigarh forthwith and to be handed over to her parents.

Petition stands disposed of as no cause of action survives.
