By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS,
2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as
under: -

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance
to the order dated 12.03.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. During the course of hearing on 12.03.2025, following order
had been passed: -



“ 2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case and no specific overt act is attributed to the petitioner. He further submits that the matter is still under investigation and in the meanwhile, compromise has been effected between the parties and the complainant Om Parkash duly served affidavit (Annexure P-2) in this regard. The petitioner is ready to join the investigation. Hence, the petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Praveen Bhadu, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has not disputed the factual matrix of the case.

5. Mr. Dhruv Sheoran, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of complainant and filed memo of appearance, which is taken on record. He has categorically stated at bar that the matter has been compromised and the complainant has given the affidavit (Annexure P-2) voluntarily and has no objection in case the petitioner is allowed to join the investigation.

6. Be it the case, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.

7. Investigating Officer of the case to remain present along with record on the next date of hearing.

8. List on 02.04.2025.”

4. Learned State counsel on instructions received from S.I. Mahinder Singh informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.



5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 12.03.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 12.03.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further, the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.

7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
