JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of B-1 selection list declared in December' 2003 whereby private respondents were declared pass and deputed for lower school course.
2. Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that he has no instructions.
3. Learned State counsel submits that private respondents were promoted and even petitioner was subsequently promoted, thus, petition has rendered infructuous.
