1. Prayer is made to dispose of this appeal in terms of order passed in LPA-290-2025, decided on 29.05.2025.
2. It transpires that there was a difference of opinion in LPA-290-2025, wherein controversy similar to one arising in this case arose for consideration.
3. The matter consequently was referred to a third Judge. Based upon the opinion of the majority, the appeal came to be disposed of on 29.08.2025. It is prayed that this appeal be decided on the same terms.
4. It appears that the claim of the present appellant was kept pending awaiting the decision of the pending LPA-290-2025, 'Surinder Lather vs. State of Haryana and others'.
5. Learned State counsel has also produced a communication received from the Chief Secretary, to the Government of Haryana, in

which, it is clearly stated that the appellant’s claim is identical to the appellant in ‘Surinder Lather vs. State of Haryana’, LPA-290-2025. The communication received from the Chief Secretary to the Government of Haryana, is taken on record.

6. We are also informed that the judgment delivered in LPA-290-2025, has been given effect to by the State.

7. In that view of the matter, this appeals stands allowed in terms of the judgment delivered in LPA-290-2025.
