1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking quashing of the order dated 02.03.2023 (Annexure P-16) passed by the Court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur, whereby without declaring the petitioner as a proclaimed offender, SHO of Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur has been directed to submit the list of property of the petitioner so as to initiate proceedings under Section 83 of the Cr.P.C against the petitioner and his property, in FIR No.159 dated 10.10.2020 registered under Sections 354, 354-A, 506 and 509 IPC and Section 67-A of the Information Technology Act, 2000(Sections 376, 511 and 342 IPC added later on) at Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur.

2. Learned Assisting counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been acquitted vide judgment dated 13.06.2025, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Court, Exclusively dealing with rape cases, Ferozepur, and therefore, he wishes to withdraw the present petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
