Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that pursuant to directions issued on 28.08.2023 in CWP-15779-2018, while acting on the representation filed by the petitioner, action against encroachment has been initiated, though learned counsel for the petitioner states that the action taken is more on paper than on the ground.

- 2. Be that as it may, for the present, no grievance seems to subsist and accordingly no further orders are required to be passed.
- 3. However, in case no concrete action is taken, the petitioner shall be at liberty to approach this Court again.
- 4. The instant contempt petition is accordingly disposed of in view of the aforesaid observations.
- 5. Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
