1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in a case stemming from FIR No.91 dated 11.04.2021 registered under Sections 420/468/471/120-B of IPC at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar (Rural).
2. Learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of an affidavit of Maninder Singh, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.
3. Same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place.
4. Learned State counsel refers to para Nos. 8 and 9 of the aforementioned short reply and submits that warrants of arrest against respondents No. 5, 7 to 9 have been obtained from the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate for 07.05.2025. Further, the departmental action has been recommended against the Investigating Officer and two other Sub Inspectors.



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5. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh further submits final report has already been filed against respondents No. 4 to 6, before the jurisdictional Court and appropriate steps would be taken, strictly in accordance with law, in terms of the judgment passed by this Court in ***Darshan Singh Vs. State of Punjab and Others*** passed in CRM-M-55907-2023 (O&M) decided on 21.12.2023.

6. As such, learned State counsel submits that grievance raised by the petitioner in the present petition has been substantially redressed.

7. In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the present petition and the same is hereby disposed of accordingly.

8. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail the alternative remedy as may be available to him, in accordance with law, in case, any grievance mentioned in the present petition, still survives.
