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**VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J.** (Oral)

1. No one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellant. As per the office report, notices were issued to the parties have been received back with the report that sole appellant has died. Respondents No.1 and 3 are also dead and respondent No.5 has gone abroad, whereas, respondents No.2 and 4 were duly served but no one has put in appearance on their behalf. No attempt has been made to implead the LRs of the appellant, so, it seems that no one is ready to pursue the instant appeal.

2. In such circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the instant appeal on the docket, indefinitely.

3. Accordingly, the instant appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution with liberty to the appellant to revive the same, if have any grievance from this order, within a period of three months from today.

4. As a natural corollary, since the main case stands dismissed for want of prosecution, all pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of, as no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping them pending.
