1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking issuance of direction to official respondents No.2 to 5 to take appropriate action on the FIR No.58 dated 17.02.2025 registered under Sections 115, 117(2), 190, 191(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Ballabgarh Sadar, District Faridabad and take action on his representation dated 22.02.2025 (Annexure P-3).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has recently filed a representation on 22.02.2025 before the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Ballabgarh, District Faridabad raising his grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.4-Deputy Commissioner



of Police, Ballabgarh, District Faridabad to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. Mr. Apoorv Garg, Sr. DAG, Haryana who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day.
- 5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioners, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.4 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 22.02.2025 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within a period of 15 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
