1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 28.01.2004 whereby Director General of Police (**DGP**) has ordered to withdraw fortuitous promotion.

2. The petitioner joined as Constable on 05.05.1986. He was promoted as Officiating Head Constable on 13.03.1992. He was further promoted as Officiating Assistant Sub Inspector (**ASI**). He was granted Own Rank Promotion (**ORP**) of Sub Inspector (**SI**). By impugned order, DGP decided to withdraw out of turn promotions. It was made clear that he would get promotion of Head Constable. His present rank was protected.

3. Neither there is representation of the petitioner nor learned State counsel is having instructions. It appears that with the efflux of time, petitioner has lost his interest to pursue the instant petition.

4. ***Dismissed*** with liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate

application within three months from today, if cause survives.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
