1. The petitioner in the instant (second) petition is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in case FIR No.126 dated 09.12.2024 under Sections 103(1), 3(5) and 238 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station Sadar Jalalabad, District Fazilka.

2. At the outset a pointed query has been put to the learned counsel for the petitioner as to what was the material change in circumstances after the withdrawal of the previous petition seeking similar relief, as recently as on 24.02.2025, wherein the following order was passed:

“After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined, a prayer was made by learned counsel for the petitioner for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has miserably failed to bring to the notice of this Court any material change in circumstances except that there is a new counsel, who is representing the petitioner. Hence, no ground is made out to entertain the instant petition.

4. Dismissed.
