MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0007 dated 29.08.2020, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station NRI, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1).

2. On 03.04.2025, the petitioner had been granted interim anticipatory bail with direction to join investigation and the relevant part of the said order reads as under: -

“Learned counsel appearing for the complainant does not dispute the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner on the last date of hearing that the parties have indeed amicably resolved all their disputes. He also does not oppose the prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner for extending the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.”



3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated that in compliance of order dated 03.04.2025, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation, much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed, and interim order dated 03.04.2025, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) BNSS.
