1. This is a Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to modify the order dated 13.03.2023 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr.Div.), Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that in the present case, the petitioner had earlier filed an application for additional evidence and in paragraph 2 of the same, a specific reference was made to the judgment dated 04.07.2014 which was also stated to be necessary for decision. It is submitted that the said application was dismissed by the trial Court vide order dated 29.07.2021 and against the said order dated 29.07.2021, a civil revision bearing no.CR-1632-2021 was filed by the present petitioner which was dismissed on 30.11.2022 and in the said order,

it was observed that the said suit is pending for the last 10 years and the trial Court was directed to dispose of the suit expeditiously. It is submitted that said three documents have not been annexed along with the present petition. It is further submitted that subsequently in spite of the abovesaid orders, the petitioner has again filed an application and a prayer for producing the judgment dated 04.07.2014 has again been made, which has also been rejected vide the impugned order.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner after seeing that this Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter and in order to avoid costs, seeks to withdraw the present petition.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
