1. Prayer made in the present petition for quashing the action of the respondents for charging compound interest on the gratuity amount.
2. Learned State counsel refers to para 4 of the written statement dated 23.02.2005 filed by Additional Secretary, Food & Supplies, Punjab, wherein it has been stated that the order passed in accordance with the instructions dated 14.07.1995, Annexure R-1, asking the petitioner to deposit an amount of Rs.51,574/- for becoming eligible for claiming pension on military service, to which there was no rebuttal by way of filing replication.
3. Disposed of, reserving the petitioner with a liberty to get it revived, in case, *lis* still survives.
