DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

1. Nobody has appeared on behalf of the appellant. Same was the position on the last date of hearing. Earlier, notice was directed to be issued to the present Sarpanch. As per the affidavit of Sh. Davinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Amargarh, the entire Gram Panchayat of Village Alipur i.e. appellant had dissolved on 26.02.2024 and presently, there was an administrator in village. Intimation was given to the said administrator, who had undertaken to appear before the Court.

2. Despite the above, nobody has appeared to represent the appellant.

3. Apart from above, it is also revealed that suit simplicitor for seeking a decree of permanent injunction filed by the plaintiff Kirpal Singh (respondent herein) was decreed by the trial Court on 28.02.1992 and the appeal filed by the defendant Panchayat was dismissed on 20.12.1994. Thus, Panchayat had assailed the concurrent findings of the Courts below.

4. Since, nobody is appearing for the appellant, it appears that



appellant is no longer interested in pursuing the appeal.
