JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to correct his pay scales and release arrears.

2. The petitioner claims that respondents have wrongly fixed his pay scale and accordingly his pension is affected. He retired on 31.03.2016 on attaining the age of superannuation. The Deputy Director, Department of Animal Husbandry, Amritsar-respondent No. 3 vide communication dated 05.12.2024 (Annexure P-9) had requested the Director to consider petitioner's claim. In the said letter, it has been noticed that petitioner was given 9 years proficiency increment from 01.01.2008. Benefit of 14 years proficiency increment has not been given to him.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court, submits that Competent Authority would consider petitioner's claim and pass an appropriate order within 3 months from today.



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4. Disposed of accordingly.
5. It is made clear that if petitioner is found entitled to 14 years proficiency increment, he would be released arrears without interest.
