1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a *mandamus* upon respondent no.1, to decide the representation dated 07.02.2025 (Annexure P-8), wherethrough, a request is made to pass an award in claim application bearing No.UDYAM-HR-03-003087/S/00001, dated 04.04.2022 under Section MSMED Act, 2006, as the arbitration proceedings have already completed by the empanned arbitrator.
2. This Court vide order dated 10.03.2025, without issuing a formal noticed passed a direction upon learned State counsel to have

instructions from respondent no.1, as to how much time is required to pass the award in the claim application (*supra*).

3. Today, learned State counsel, after having instruction from Mr. Ashutosh, Law Officer, MSME, inform this Court that the award on the claim application (*supra*), will be passed within a period of 03 months from today.

4. In view of the above specific statement suffered by the learned State counsel, no further direction is required to be passed in the instant matter. Therefore, the instant petition, is **disposed of**.
