By way of present petition filed under Section 482 BNSS, 2023, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
24	20.02.2025	118(2), 126(2), 351(2), 191(2), 191(3), 190 BNS	Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that in compliance to the order dated 10.03.2025, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

3. During the course of hearing on 10.03.2025, following order had been passed: -

“ Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in criminal case having FIR



No.24 dated 20.02.2025 registered under Sections 118(2), 126(2), 351(2), 191(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS, 2023 at Police Station Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Counsel for the petitioners inter alia submits that the petitioners are falsely named in the FIR and otherwise also only slaps/fist and kick blows are attributed to the present petitioners. It is further submitted that the case involves version as well as cross-version and in cross-version case co-accused Sandeep Singh @ Sipa is complainant. It is further submitted that actually the other party is the aggressor party and that the petitioners, who are having no criminal history, are ready and willing to join investigation with the police.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar submits that no doubt only simple injuries are attributed to the present petitioners, who were empty handed, but they are required by the police for the purpose of proper investigation. The State counsel has also not disputed the fact that the case involves version as well as cross-version and co-accused Sandeep Singh @ Sipa is complainant in cross-version case. It is also not disputed that the petitioners are having no criminal history.

In view of the fact that only fist and kick blows are attributed to the present petitioners, who were not having any weapons with them at the time of occurrence, the petitioners are hereby directed to join investigation with the police and in case of arrest, they are directed to be released on interim bail by the IO/Arresting Officer to his own satisfaction till the next date of hearing. The petitioners are to abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

Now be listed on 26.05.2025.”

4. Learned State counsel on instructions received from ASI Pawan Kumar informs the Court that the petitioners have joined the



investigation and are neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioners had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 10.03.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 10.03.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further the petitioners are directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioners; they will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.

7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
