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**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of order dated 13.02.2004 and 12.02.2004 whereby respondent asked Head Constables, Assistant Sub Inspectors and Sub Inspectors to appear in B-1 Test for making themselves eligible for next promotion.

2. Learned State counsel submits that petitioners had either retired or passed away or have been promoted, thus, petition has rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel representing the petitioners submits that he has no instructions. He further submits that the petition may be disposed of with liberty to move an appropriate application within six months from today, if cause survives.
