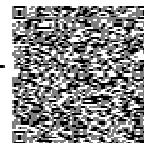

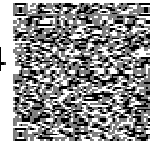
1. On 18.03.2025 the following order was passed by this

Court: -

“By invoking Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the petitioner has prayed for quashing of FIR No.164 dated 05.09.2023 registered under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) (Annexure P-1) and all other subsequent proceedings arising thereof on the basis of compromise dated 23.01.2025 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

*On receipt of advance copy, learned State counsel has put in appearance and has relied upon the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court passed in **Daxaben Vs. State of Gujarat and others : 2022(3) Crimes 224** to contend that*

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the FIR registered under Section 306 of IPC cannot be quashed on the basis of compromise.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks an adjournment to go through the abovesaid judgment and address arguments.

Adjourned to 15.05.2025.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
