MANISHA BATRA. J.(Oral)

1. The petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate direction to official respondents no.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 9.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that an FIR bearing No.53 has been registered against the private respondents on 28.03.2025 at Police Station Ajnala.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he would be satisfied if the petitioner is provided protection at the hands of private respondents.
4. The present petition is disposed of with the direction to official respondents to assess the threat perception, if any existing *qua* the petitioner and to provide appropriate security in according with the law, if required.
