1. Prayer in the instant petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to provide protection of lives and liberty to the petitioners, who have married against the wishes of the private respondents.
2. On being pointed out by the Court that in paragraph No.2 of the petition, petitioners have mentioned their religion as Sikh and marriage certificate, which is appended with the present petition is shown to have been issued by Prachin Pashupati Nath Shiv Mandir (Regd), Sector-6 Panchkula, Haryana. Even, no photographs of marriage have been appended with the petition.
3. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file fresh one with correct particulars.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as sought and recorded hereabove.
