1. Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for short "BNSS, 2023", (erstwhile Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for short "Cr.P.C."), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.48 dated 14.04.2024, registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron) at Police Station Cantonment, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.
2. After arguing for some time, learned for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition, with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and file an appropriate application for bail and the trial Court may be directed to dispose of the same in a time bound manner.
3. Allowed to do so.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed for. If the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of 3 days from today and files application for bail, then the trial Court would decide the same expeditiously in accordance with law.
