1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS with a prayer to quash the FIR No.98, dated 05.07.2022, under Sections 307,506,148,149 of IPC and Sections 25,27,54,59 of Arms Act, Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising out therefrom.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 20.01.2025 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to look into representation dated 20.01.2025 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate action within two weeks, in accordance with law.

4. Disposed off.
