SANJAY VASHISTH, J.

1. On 12.03.2025, following order was passed:-

“Contends, inter alia, that petitioner has been nominated on the basis of disclosure made by co-accused-Shinderpal Singh @ Jain, who happens to be son of petitioner, from whom alleged contraband i.e. 81 grams heroin (non-commercial quantity) was recovered.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kunwarbir Singh, learned AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent; seeks time to have instructions and/or to file written response in the matter. Posted for 06.05.2025.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join investigation before the Investigating Officer; but he be not arrested till the next date of hearing.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the order dated 12.03.2025, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation, and has fully co-operated.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions, confirms the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner would not be required now for the purpose of investigation.

4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.



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5. Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and since custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and ad-interim order dated 12.03.2025, passed by this Court is hereby made absolute.

However, petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the terms and conditions laid down under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

6. Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.
