In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of direction to the respondents to release the amount of the medical reimbursement bill for treatment of his father.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner on instructions from the petitioner submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied

if a direction is given to respondent No.4 to decide the legal notice(Annexure P-5) served by the petitioner.

In view of the statement given by the counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 4 to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-5) within a period of four months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. Liberty is also granted to the petitioner to submit additional representation, if so advised. In event, as additional representation is submitted by the petitioner, the same shall also be taken into consideration while deciding the legal notice (Annexure P-5). In event, the petitioner is found entitled for grant of relief, as per rules, the same may be released within a period of one month, thereafter.
