Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, praying for quashing of FIR No.376 dated 01.08.2017 (P-1), under Section 379-B read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 27.02.2023 (P-2), arrived at between the parties.

2. Case called twice; but none appeared on behalf of the petitioners. On earlier occasion also, none appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

3. Learned State counsel submits that despite order dated 29.03.2023 passed by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, none came forward for recording their statement before learned trial Court .



- 4. In view of the above, it appears that petitioners have lost interest in the matter.

- 5. Consequently, there is no option except to dispose off the same for non-prosecution.

- 6. Ordered accordingly.

- 7. Needless to say that in case an occasion so arises, petitioners would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.
