1. The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus, directing respondents No.2 and 3 to release the alleged detainee-Sakeena Rani (wife of the petitioner) from the illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 9.

2. Learned State counsel has filed the affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sri Muktsar Sahib, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, which is taken on record.

3. In compliance of order dated 10.03.2025, report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib, who had been directed by this Court vide the above said order, to interact with the alleged detainee and get her statement recorded, has been received and perused.

4. As per the report received, detainee-Sakeena Rani had suffered a statement to the effect that she is happily married with one Sunny (respondent No.8 herein) and is residing with him out of her free will, voluntarily and without any pressure.

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5. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the instant petition as the alleged detainee does not wish to accompany the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the instant petition stands disposed of.
