JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to consider his case for regularization.
2. The petitioner was appointed as Peon on 08.01.1989. The respondent terminated him in 1999. He came to be reinstated vide judgment dated 24.04.2008 passed by Labour Court with continuity of service and 50% back wages.
3. The petitioner is claiming that he has filed representation on 21.02.2024 claiming regularization as per Policies framed by State Government.
4. Mr. Prince Singh, Advocate submits that competent authority has already forwarded his case to Deputy Commissioner, Bhiwani.
5. Mr. Sharma submits that competent authority would consider claim of petitioner and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law.
6. Without expressing opinion on merits, instant petition stands disposed of. Let the needful be done within 3 months from today.
