1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents to immediately complete the police verification process and submit the police verification report to the Regional Passport Office, Chandigarh without any delay.
2. In pursuance of advance copies of petition having been served upon respondents, Ms. Komal Preet Chauhan, Senior Panel Counsel and Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG Haryana appear on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2 and respondents no. 3 and 4, respectively.
