The petitioner has approached this Court for directing the respondent No.2 to decide the appeal dated 25.07.2024 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioner expeditiously.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in case the respondent No.2-Director General, State Transport Department, Haryana is directed to decide the appeal (Annexure P-5) and the grievance espoused by the petitioner therein by passing a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.
