Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.11 dated 25.01.2025, registered under Sections 305, 331(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, at Police Station Ranjit Avenue, District Amritsar.

Vide order dated 26.03.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 26.03.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 26.03.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands allowed.
