1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.150, dated 26.08.2023, under Sections 304 of IPC, registered at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur.

2. An Additional status report by way of an affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, District Hoshiarpur has been filed on behalf of respondent-State and the same is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel submits that during the course of investigation, it has been found that Section 304 of IPC has been deleted and Section 304-A of IPC has been added in the present case. He further contends that since the offence under Section 304-A of IPC is bailable, the present petition will not be maintainable before this Court.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further

directions are required and the petition is accordingly, disposed of.

4. The petitioner shall be at liberty to appear before the concerned Court/Investigating Officer in the present case and may apply for bail in the present case.
