JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and not to allow the private respondents No.4 and 5 to interfere in the life of the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in pursuance of the order dated 27.03.2023 passed by this Court, the pre-charge evidence has already been undertaken before the learned trial Court and vide aforesaid order, protection was also granted to the petitioners. He further submitted that the petitioners may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with a liberty that



in case in future any threat exists qua the petitioners then they may approach the concerned police officer/Station House Officer, who should consider their request in accordance with law.

3. Learned State counsel submitted that in case in future there is any threat to the petitioners and they make any such application to the concerned Station House Officer, then the concerned Station House Officer will immediately consider the threat perception of the petitioners and thereafter, will take appropriate action, in case it is so required.

4. Learned counsel for respondents No.4 and 5 submitted that respondents No.4 and 5 have never posed any threat to the petitioners nor in future will pose any threat to the petitioners.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.
