Present application seeking leave to appeal has been filed against the impugned judgment dated 16.01.2019 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Karnal whereby complaint preferred by appellant under Sections 416, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 205, 210, 120B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 against accused-respondent, has been dismissed.

(2) At the outset, in view of judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in case titled as "*Celestium Financial Vs. A. Gnanasekaran and Others*" reported in *2025 INSC 804*, learned counsel, on instructions, from



applicant wishes to withdraw the present application with liberty to take recourse to remedy available before learned Sessions Court.
