The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.86 dated 24.03.2023 registered under Sections 363, 366-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 376(3) & 376(2)(n) of IPC and Sections 4(2) & 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act, 2012 were added later on) at Police Station Sadar, Kaithal.
