1. The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of necessary directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the petitioners life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset submits that for their grievance, the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 15.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur i.e respondent No. 2, but no action has been taken thereon so far. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if their representation dated 15.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) is decided by the authorities in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Amandeep Singh Samra, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. A copy of the paper book be

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supplied to him during the course of the day.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation (Annexure P-1) of the petitioners and take the necessary action as per law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
