1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No. 2 (Regional Passport Officer, Chandigarh) to decide the representation dated 10.02.2025 (Annexure P-3), submitted by the petitioner.
