Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 6 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of respondents no.7 and 8. While drawing the attention of this Court learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that representation has been given to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab with respect to the continuous harassment being caused to the petitioner by respondents no.7 and 8. Learned counsel submits that for no fault of her, the police has been calling her to police station. Hence, she fears for the life and liberty at the hands of private respondents no.7 and 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural to look into her representation dated 24.02.2025 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. H.S. Deol, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural to look into the representation dated 24.02.2025 (Annexure P-2) and take necessary steps, as may be required, in accordance with law.
