1. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Sh. Moneesh Kumar, Director, Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed in Court, the same is taken on record.
2. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that some issue with respect to the payment of house rent/penalty on account of overstay beyond 04 months by the petitioner is pending consideration and an appropriate order thereupon shall be passed upon hearing the petitioner within two weeks from today whereas the remaining amount payable to the petitioner shall be released in his favour within the said two weeks besides passing appropriate speaking order on the claims put forth by him in paragraph 19 of the present petition.
