1. Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C has been filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.191, dated 03.09.2021, registered under Sections 363 and 366-A IPC (Section 376 IPC and Sections 4 & 6 of POCSO Act were added later on), at Police Station Sadar Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.
2. It is mentioned in prayer clause 13 of the petition that earlier application of the petitioner for regular bail i.e. CRM-M-6634-2024 was dismissed as withdrawn on 17.05.2024. Copy of the said order has not been attached with the petition. However, perusal of the order dated 17.05.2024 shows that the bail application of the petitioner was rejected on merits by passing a detailed order. There is active concealment on the part of the petitioner.
3. In view of above, the present petition stands dismissed.
