AMAN CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer made in the present petition is for quashing the order dated 27.09.2019, Annexure P-6, vide which case of the petitioner for compassionate appointment has been rejected on account of being involved in various criminal offences.

2. Learned counsel refers to the averments made in paras 10 and 11 of the petition specifically detailing therein that it was due to political vendetta, the petitioner was falsely implicated in 5 criminal cases of which he was acquitted, vide judgments Annexures P-7 to P-11, as on the date of his consideration. Further a specific reference has been made to the order dated 13.10.2014, Annexure P-12, and para 13(c), of the Standing Order, Annexure P-13, issued by the Police Department for



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recruitment of Constables, to submit that the criminal cases wherein the petitioner was acquitted, would not fall within those specified therein.

3. The aforesaid facts having been brought out, during the course of hearing, learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the respondents shall re-examine the matter and decide afresh, taking note of the afore submissions, within a period of 6 months, uninfluenced by the orders impugned in the present case, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner.

4. The aforesaid satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. The matter stands disposed of accordingly and if the petitioner is found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same may be passed after granting opportunity of hearing to him and shall contain reasons, whereupon he shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
