VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J. (Oral)

1. Mr. Jayant Singh Chauhan, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.3-Insurance Company and filed his memo of appearance, which is taken on record.

2. No one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellants today. It is a fully burnt case. The matter was referred to Mediation but no one on behalf of the appellants appeared before the learned Mediator, so it seems that appellants are not ready to pursue the appeal.

3. In such circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the instant appeal on the docket, indefinitely.

4. Accordingly, the instant appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution with liberty to the appellants to revive the same, if have any grievance from this order, within a period of three months from today.
