1. Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 (earlier Section 438 Cr.P.C.), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked in a criminal case arising out of First Information Report, as detailed hereunder:-

2. On 17.03.2025, following order was passed:-

1. *Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 (earlier Section 438 Cr.P.C.), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked in a criminal case arising out of First Information Report, as detailed hereunder:-*

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2. *Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that co-accused namely Arvinder Singh has also been named in the FIR, and in separate petition filed by him, i.e. CRM-M-9253-2025, interim anticipatory bail has been granted to him by this Court, which is now fixed for 22.04.2025.*

However, counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the fact that role assigned to co-accused namely Arvinder Singh, is quite different to the role assigned to the petitioner.

3. *He also submits that as per the version in the FIR, alleged incident took place at about 8.30 P.M., but petitioner, in fact, was present at the marriage function of Surinder Kaur, who is daughter of Harvinder Singh, from 6.45 P.M. to 1.00 P.M. However, he requests that the facts be verified by the investigating agency, first.*

4. *Notice of motion.*

5. *On advance notice, Mr. Amandeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, puts in appearance on behalf of the respondent – State. Copy of the complete paper book, along with appended documents, is handed over in the Court by counsel for the petitioner to learned State counsel.*

6. *Adjourned to 08.04.2025.*

7. *Let the submissions addressed by counsel for the petitioner today before this Court, be verified by learned State*



counsel and file status report in the matter, on the next date of hearing.

- 3. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.
