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order: -

“In the present case, Jagroop Singh had filed a suit for declaration to the effect that the order dated 18.02.1987, vide which his services had been terminated by the defendants, was illegal, null and void.

The trial Court vide judgment and decree dated 19.08.1995 had partly decreed the said suit and had set aside the order dated 18.02.1987 vide which services of the said Jagroop Singh were terminated and further liberty was granted to the Federation to furnish copy of the report of the Enquiry Officer to the plaintiff and to initiate fresh action after affording him a reasonable opportunity to show cause against the quantum of punishment. The appeal against the same by the defendant has also been dismissed.

A perusal of the paperbook would show that there is no stay operating in either of the appeals.

Learned counsel for the federation prays for an adjournment to get instructions as to whether the federation has taken any action against the plaintiff, which liberty was granted by the trial Court and the appellate Court.

Further instructions would be taken by the counsel for the federation to the effect that in case, no such action has been taken, as to whether the plaintiff has served, since, his termination order was set aside and as to whether in the said circumstances, any cause survives in the present appeal or not.
