1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 483 of BNSS, with a prayer to grant regular bail to him in case FIR No.7 dated 28.01.2024, registered under Sections 379-B IPC (Sections 201, 341, 323, 324 IPC added later on), Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was arrested in the present case on 13.04.2024 and is in custody for the last more than 11 months. By referring to the orders Annexures P-4 to P-6, learned counsel submits that other similarly placed co-accused Bhupinder Singh, Jagpreet Singh @ Jagga and Rajbeer Singh have already been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court. Since the challan has already been



presented against the petitioner, there are total 14 witnesses in the present case but no witness has been examined so far. Thus, the conclusion of the trial may take quite a long time and further custody of the petitioner will not serve any meaningful purpose.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that serious allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner and he does not deserve the concession of bail by this Court.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

5. It is an admitted fact that similarly placed co-accused Bhupinder Singh, Jagpreet Singh @ Jagga and Rajbeer Singh have already been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court vide orders Annexures P-4 to P-6. The petitioner is at par with the said accused and is in custody for the last about 11 months.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
